The bipartisan-supported **ABLE Age Adjustment Act**, introduced in the last Congress as S. 817/H.R. 1874 and soon to be reintroduced, makes the ABLE program available to people with disabilities who become disabled later in life (prior to age 46), thereby correcting this inequity and ensuring the ABLE program's long-term viability.
