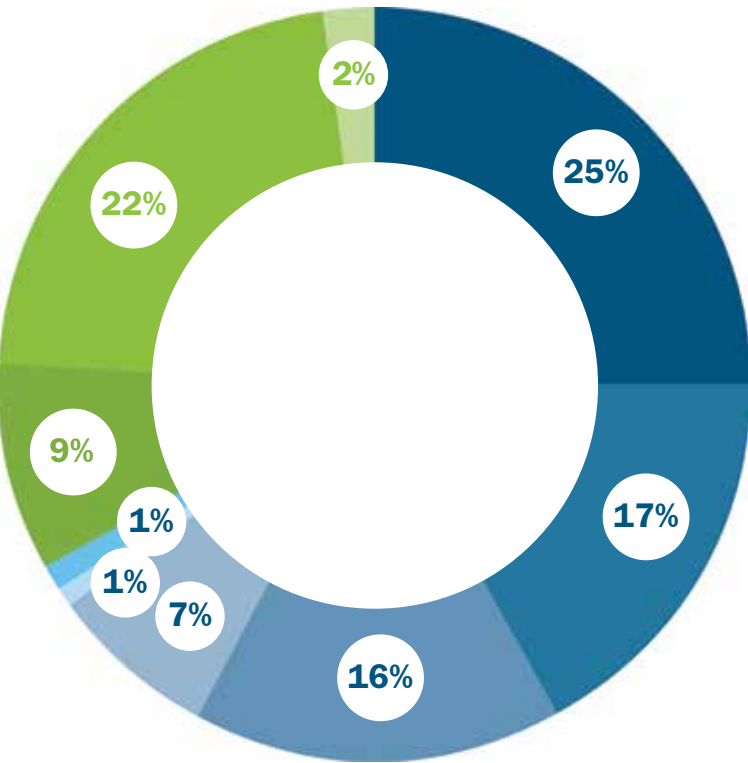

Portfolio Allocation December 2016



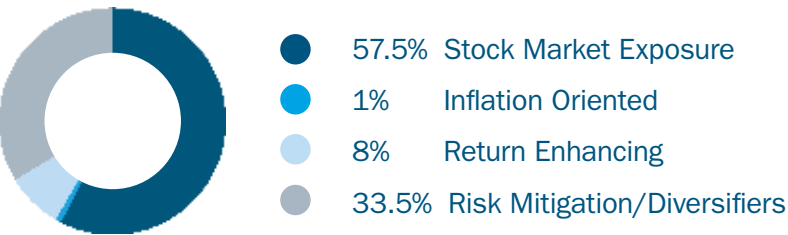

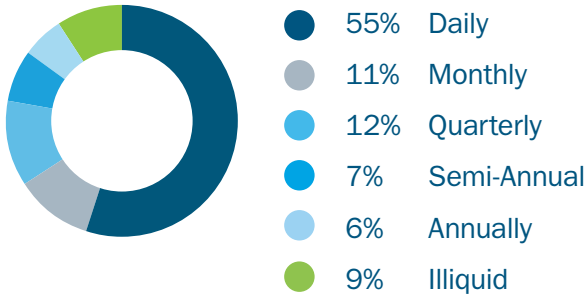
