Organizational Vision, Mission, and Function:

Position Overview:

The Development Officer of Women's Philanthropy will report to the Director of Women's Philanthropy/Philanthropic Leadership. This position requires experience working with lay leaders to plan meaningful and effective fundraising-related events, soliciting annual campaign gifts and managing a fundraising portfolio with a primary focus on philanthropic women and their households. The position will also partner with lay leaders to work with donors, other lay leaders and committees.

Primary Responsibilities

- Cultivate and maintain relationships with donors and prospects.
- Initiate and develop outreach programs and donor events.
- Manage a fundraising portfolio with an emphasis in planning and implementing the
 effective identification, cultivation, face-to-face solicitation and stewardship of donors
 in WP giving \$500-\$4,999.
- Create, organize and implement fundraising and leadership development strategies and tactics.
- Manage a team of Women's Philanthropy Ambassadors
- Train and support lay leaders by developing strategies for committees, meetings and events, and developing appropriate written materials including annotated agendas and operational plans (timelines for projects, solicitor recruitment plans).

- In partnership with lay leaders and professional colleagues, the Development Officer plans, implements, and evaluates a creative and aggressive campaign of donors, including:
 - Solicitor recruitment, training and ongoing support
 - Empowerment and development of current and future lay leaders to feel a high degree of ownership, involvement, and responsibility toward fulfillment of the Federation mission:
 - Insuring donor satisfaction by providing the highest level of customer service;

Requirements

- 2-5 years' experience with some combination of donor centered fundraising and solicitation.
- Experience in strategic and operational planning.
- First-hand knowledge of the Jewish community, its customs and practices
- Knowledge of fundraising systems and experience in prospect identification.
- Previous experience with working with volunteer committees
- Strong donor/customer-relations skills: proven ability in creating strategies to cultivate prospects and channel donor engagement leading to greater charitable support.
- Excellent communication skills verbal, oral, written.
- Proven ability to work collaboratively and effectively with colleagues at all levels.
- Demonstrated creativity, initiative and flexibility.
