Day One: Monday, October 23, 2017 ARRIVAL & WELCOME

- For those arriving early, there is an opportunity to explore the Tel Aviv Museum of Art: View the vast collection of fine art at the Tel Aviv Museum of Art, one of Israel's leading cultural institutions. Its combination of international and Israeli art reflects the Tel Aviv spirit of inspiring creativity both locally and abroad.
- Welcome event, including cocktails and dinner at the Tel Aviv Museum of Art. Explore the comprehensive solo exhibition dedicated to groundbreaking French-American artist Louise Bourgeois (1911–2010), one of the most brilliant, prominent, and influential women in 20th-century art.

- Israeli Fashion Today: Enjoy a showcase of Israeli fashion and jewelry design, led and curated by fashion expert Galit Reismann. There will be an option for members of all tracks to do some purchasing.

Business – Spirit of Innovation

USING LOCAL RESOURCES FOR GLOBAL BENEFIT

- Israel, A Start-Up: Visit the State of Mind Innovation Center in the Tel Aviv Stock Exchange, a world-class exhibit on Israel's start-up ventures that are impacting the country and the world. The center was designed to introduce Taglit-Birthright Israel participants to the hi-tech industry and employs state-of-the-art technology to highlight Israel's entrepreneurship and innovation.
- Visit the **Facebook Israel** offices and meet with a representative of the Facebook team. Discuss Facebook Israel's operations and their decision to establish a branch in Tel Aviv.
- Lunch on own at the Rothschild Allenby Market.
- Visit F2 Capital, an early-stage venture capital fund backing frontier technology companies in Israel and learn about new companies that will have a big impact on the future. Hear about "The Junction" program, which provides assistance to young startups including an initial funding of \$100k, free workspace, access to Fortune 500 companies, and expert mentorship in the industry.
- 365Scores: Visit the 365Scores office on Rothschild Boulevard and gain insight into one of Israel's most successful apps. Meet with MASA participants working at 365Scores. MASA Israel Journey connects Jewish young adults (ages 18-30) to gap year, study abroad, post-college, and volunteer programs.

Day Two: Tuesday, October 24, 2017 ISRAEL TRACK DAY ONE

Eco Israel/Outdoor Adventure - Sunrise to Sunset

EXPLORE ISRAEL'S COASTAL SHORELINE

- Depart the hotel with overnight bags (without checking out of the hotel).
- Participate in a Jewish Agency pre-army academy (mechina) program. Meet young Israelis training in preparation for their army service. Experience field-navigation and a mini "boot camp" before joining the mechina for "real life" IDF army training.
- Visit the Marine Sciences Campus, which is supported by The Jewish Federation of Greater Washington. The campus is part of the Ruppin Academic Center located on Michmoret beach. Navigate the waters on a research vessel and see offshore fish cages. Then meet with a leading scientist from the center to discuss important new projects and visit the sea turtle rescue center.
- Lunch at the Marine Sciences Campus.
- Another Look at the Mediterranean: Hike along the Mediterranean Coast with participants from Honeymoon Israel. The hike will begin at Habonim Beach, and take in the historical Dor Beach and the Cleopatra Cave before arriving at the Bay of Shells in time to catch the sunset. Together with Honeymoon.
- Israeli Martial Arts: Train in Krav-Maga, a self-defense system developed for the IDF.
- Check into the Nahsholim Holiday Village kibbutz hotel.
- **Dinner** at the **Adama** Restaurant in **Zichron Ya'acov**, one of the first communities established by Zionist pioneers.
- Enjoy s'mores and fire-roasted potatoes at a Kumzits (Israeli bonfire) on the beach.

- Meet with Member of Knesset Itzik Shmuli, one of the leaders of Israel's 2011 social justice protests and now a member of the Labor Party. Discuss the challenges facing young Israelis today and the efforts in place to build a better future.
- Creating our New Community: Visit the Shahaff community in Lod and meet the young people who are creating a new life together while also working to help one of Israel's poorer and most diverse cities. Shahaff is one of the 185 new communities that have been established throughout Israel which combine community building with social action. Tour the neighborhood and experience the challenges and achievements of this inspiring movement.
- Lunch with the Shahaff community.
- Return to Tel Aviv.
- My Tel Aviv: Split into small groups and tour the streets of Tel Aviv. Visit homes, workplaces and hang-out spaces and feel the spirit of this innovative and inspiring city. The tours will be led by young people who will share their personal experiences of living in Tel Aviv.

- Tikva In: Visit the Hatikva neighbourhood, one of the poorer parts of Tel Aviv, which provides fascinating insight into the ethnic and socio-economic diversity of the city. A local resident will discuss the large Yemenite Jewish community in the neighborhood and will accompany the group to one of their beautiful synagogues. The visit will be followed by a tasting tour at Hatikva's open-air market with food (and people) from around the world. Tikva In is part of the Jewish Agency's Ketzev program and provides support to young Israelis who are building "social businesses," businesses created and designed to address social problems.
- Eat **lunch** at **Blackout**, a restaurant completely in the dark and staffed by the blind. Your senses of taste and smell will expand as you enjoy the delicious food without using your eyes.
- The Urban Art Scene of South Tel Aviv: Gain backdoor access to galleries and art spaces with artist in residence Shirel Horowitz. Meet with artists who have put Tel Aviv at the forefront of the national and international art scene, and engage in dialogue with gallery owners.
- Dancing Against All the Odds: Meet local dancer and artist Tamar Borer and hear the remarkable story
 of how Tamar uses dance to overcome the great obstacles she has faced in her life.
- It's Five O'Clock in Tel Aviv! Happy hour at a trendy Tel Aviv eatery, with time to enjoy the ambiance, the drinks and the cuisine that will capture your imagination and your taste buds.

COMING TOGETHER, ACHIEVEMENTS AND CHALLENGES FOR NEW OLIM

- Explore the diversity and dynamism of Jewish life at the renovated Beit Hatfutsot the Museum of the Jewish People. The exhibition Operation Moses: 30 Years After traces the remarkable story of the Ethiopian Jewish migration to Israel. Two participants from this great Aliyah will be on hand to talk about their journey to Israel and their experiences in Israel.
- Visit the exhibition Heroes: Trailblazers of the Jewish People together with students from the Beit Shemesh center for youth at risk and take part in an interactive exploration of "Who is my hero?"
- Lunch on own and depart for **Jerusalem**.
- In the Heart of it All: Visit the JAFI Situation Room with Arielle Di-Porto. See how JAFI's rescue operations handle crises for Jewish communities around the world.
- Meet with former Member of Knesset Dov Lipman, who made Aliyah in 2004 from Silver Spring, Maryland, and was elected to the 19th Knesset in 2013 with the Yesh Atid Party. Hear about his journey, and the challenges he faced as a new immigrant and as a politician.

- Meet as a group to recite the traditional "shehechiyanu" blessing at Teddy Park overlooking the walls of the Old City, joined by Sallai Meridor, International Chairman of the Jerusalem Foundation and former Ambassador to the United States.

Discover a fascinating underground military complex and prison compound from the 19th century that also provides remarkable archaeological evidence on the history of Jerusalem since the First Temple.

OPTION 3:

• Rolling Around Jerusalem: Segway your way along the promenades of the Old City, stopping at different observation points to view Old and New Jerusalem.

OPTION 4:

■ A Multi-Cultural Tasting Journey: Explore the hustle and bustle of Jerusalem's Machaneh Yehudah open-air market: Enjoy the sights, smells, tastes and sounds of this vibrant area where Jerusalemites shop.

OPTION 5:

Jerusalem on Two Wheels: Bike through the hills of Jerusalem with Alyn Active, an organization dedicated to supporting ALYN Hospital, a world leader in the rehabilitation of children who have been severely injured or born with significant physical challenges.

SHABBAT IN JERUSALEM

- Breakfast at the hotel.

OPTION 2:

- Visit the Pool of Bethesda and St. Anne's Crusader church, followed by a walk along the Via Dolorosa, passing by the Ecce Homo Arch and the Sisters of Zion Convent, ending at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

OPTION 3:

- Free Shabbat morning in Jerusalem for an opportunity to explore (on own):
 - The **Old City Ramparts** for a walk along the ancient walls of the city (a voucher will be provided).
 - The **Tower of David Museum** where the story of Jerusalem, from the time of Abraham to the end of the British Mandate over Palestine, is told with exciting exhibitions and in an astonishing location.
 - The renewed Israel Museum with its fascinating collections that range from archaeology and the Dead Sea scrolls to Jewish life and art, and from an open-air model of Jerusalem during the Second Temple to contemporary Israeli and European art.

- Creating a Common Memory of Israel & the Diaspora: Dialogue with Avraham Infeld, former Director of the Israeli Chais Foundation, Chair of the Honeymoon Israel Advisory Board, and mentor of Reut's Nation State Project. - Experiences, Emotions, and Thoughts for the Future: Join members of your track for a group conversation and share experiences and memories from your journey in Israel.
