Create new programs for PJ Library grandparents and for PJ Our Way 'tweens

Created the PJOW Book Club with Gesher as well as resources for grandparents such as the Shavuot Grandfriend: Cooking Together.

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1. Increase PJ Library subscriptions.

2. Have more families participate in family programming.

3. Have them make long-lasting connections to the Jewish community.

4. Create connections with other agencies to create partner programs.

Offer workshops and/or training to family programming professionals with a goal to increase the quality of the program experience and social interactions at the family programs

Added Family Engagement tracks to the Early Childhood and Family Education Conference in December, brought in speakers to the FECoP meetings, and provided individualized support to family programming professionals.

Had a number of new programs that made the switch to virtual platforms, and increased the data collection on attending families

COVID Impact: We shifted our programs online but have been able to send the books to families' homes. We have heard directly from families through research from PJ Library (officially available at the end of November) that the books have been a lifeline during the pandemic. We have been able to offer online programs as well as providing resources to support families celebrating holidays and incorporating rituals in new ways.
