The Haberman Institute for Jewish Studies will hire a part-time staff member to facilitate a Northern Virginia expansion of our adult learning opportunities by building new partnerships with congregations, Gesher, Pozez JCC, and other Jewish communal organizations. Our initial proposal, developed before the current pandemic safety precautions were established, envisioned expanded on-site programs in Northern Virginia including lectures, cultural events, and classes. Given the restrictions, our efforts will focus on partnering with organizations in order to increase participation of Northern Virginia residents in our online programs and to develop new online programs with our partners. We will hold on-site programs in Northern Virginia with our partners if the opportunity arises in 2021.
