# NOVA Field Fellow | Impact Grant

One Table will continue to serve the Jewish young adult population in Northern Virginia through one-on-one support tailored to the needs of the individual community member, as well regional and local programming and partnerships designed to weave community connections and strengthen community members' ability to host each other. Our local Field Manager will help us to meet Jewish young adults where they are, providing the resources that they need to create unique, personally meaningful Shabbat dinner experiences for themselves and for their peers. NoVA-based participants should have the same access to Shabbat as Jewish young adults based in DC, and this partnership between OneTable and the Jewish Federation of Greater Washington is making that personalized support possible. Funding will continue to support the cost of our local staff as well as nourishment of One Table dinners in NoVA.
